Reporting to the Mine Services Supervisor, the position is responsible for the safe operation of equipment, installation of and undertaking preventative maintenance and repairs to pumps, standpipes, dewatering pipelines and in pit bores; installation of ground support (cable bolts, straps); installation and maintenance of road signage & delineation; building and maintenance of roadways, windrows, park-up areas, go-lines, hardstand and haul roads. The position will at times be required to assist in other work areas on the Koolan site, including operation of other types of surface mining equipment, providing competency in that equipment has been attained.

Mechanical Fitting/ Diesel Fitter National Accredited Certification is desirable.
