Reporting to the Senior Mine Geologist, the primary focus of this role is to provide technical assistance to the Site Technical Services and Environment Departments. A diverse role encompassing Geological, Environment, and Survey tasks this will suit people who are self-starters and willing to learn new skills.

Key Responsibilities:

- Organise, undertake and monitor effective grade control sampling programs to meet production requirements
- Monitor the excavation of ore blocks to ensure dilution is minimized and ore recovery is maximized
- Assist with daily database updates and data entry as required
- Assist with the collection of geological data from wall and face mapping
- Provide assistance for the Site surveyors including ore mark-ups, drill patterns and complete basic survey functions like bench height pegging and hole pick-ups
- Assist with Environment Surveys (water sampling, quarterly quoll monitoring, pre-clearance surveys etc.)
- Assist in maintaining the Site Geotechnical Monitoring program (plezometers, radar etc.)
- Any other activities as directed that are within your capabilities.
