### DAMBIMANGARI TRADITIONAL OWNERS STRONGLY ENCOURAGED TO APPLY

The Trainee Rangers role will involve the following:

- Participate and successfully complete all training for rangers offered by DAC.
- Participate in 'on-country' patrols up to 13 days at a time.
- Perform all duties as directed and under supervision.
- Participate in the collection of useful data and ensure that it is safely recorded.
- Follow and carry out OHS procedures in the workplace
- Ensure all incidents are recorded as soon as practicable.
- Provide and apply basic first aid and respond to emergencies when necessary.
- Maintain a safe workplace environment.
- Take part in all safety inductions.
- Attend and participate in all meetings.

This role is based in Derby and you will be working with the Health Country Team on Dambimangari Country.

#### Essential:

- Must be a Dambimangari Traditional Owner
- Current National Police Clearance required or ability to obtain
- Working with Children Clearance or ability to obtain.
- "C" class WA drivers licence.
- Attend at least six (6) remote-based field operation activities per year.
- Be available and able to work away from home at short notice.
- Undertake all training opportunities provided by DAC.
- Be physically fit and capable of working in a strenuous environment.
- Be motivated and passionate about being a ranger.
- Ability to undertake a pre-employment medical
