- Provide internal training about Cultural safety matters.

This role is based in Derby and you will be working with the Health Country Team on Dambimangari Country.

- Ability to communicate effectively with elders and DAC stakeholders.
- Previous experience as a Ranger.
- Experience with standard operating procedures.
- Sound literacy and numeracy skills.
- Working with Children Clearance or ability to obtain.

- Coxswain NC2
- Represent DAC Ranger Program at all forums.
- Good organisational skills and time management.
- Ability to undertake a pre-employment medical.
- Previous experience with environmental management programs
- Ability to operate a range of machinery.

- Current First Aid certificate
